Recommendation on the continued role of ESA in Cassini

At its 126th meeting held on January 14-15 2008 at ESA Headquarters, Paris, the Solar System Working Group (SSWG) discussed the role of ESA in the collaborative ESA/NASA Cassini/Huygens mission after the formal end of the Huygens part. The SSWG understands that without an ESA project office, Cassini essentially becomes a NASA only mission despite the presence onboard of several European instruments.

The members of the SSWG expect that a continued ESA support for the science exploitation of the Cassini could be a very cost-effective way for the coordination and visibility of the outer solar system research community in Europe that is preparing for the LAPLACE or TANDEM missions. The SSWG thus invites the ESA executive to study the need and opportunity for further support to the Cassini mission.
